PLO 3 Encompassing: Promote multicultural sensitivity. Determine one's own identity, culture, and heritage and seek to learn more about others while confronting prejudices and discrimination.

PLO 4 Empowered: Prepare to execute. Broaden knowledge of a wider world and establish ability to deal with complexity, diversity, and change.
